

REPORT TO ARC - STOKE CLUB NATIONAL - 2 JUL 05

1. The Stoke CN was held on 2 Jul 05 and numerous difficulties were experienced with electronic timing. Following the event, the TD alerted Chair STP to a potential error in the results. Consequently, it was decided by Chair STP and Chair ARC that the results should be put in abeyance pending a review by the TD and Chair STP. An appropriate notice was placed on the Snowsport England and Britski websites. I am now in a position to report on that review.

BACKGROUND

2. The Jury and Chf of Calcs were experienced but the Chf of Calcs was out of practice with the timing equipment in use.

3. There were communication difficulties between timing and start due to interference on the radio network.

4. The race was progressed at a brisk pace and, at times, the timing team were unable to 'control' the release of racers.

5. The timing system was set up such that 2 separate actions were required to record each DNF. Lack of current practice with the system meant that the Chf of Calcs omitted one of those actions on occasion, leading to a need to recover the situation when time permitted.

6. There was a problem with the main timing system which kept losing signal. This meant there were a number of back-up times to be calculated for the day. A number of solutions were tried to alleviate the problem but with little success. In all 25 backup times had to be calculated. NB: The following day, the system aerials were elevated and there were no problems.

7. All these factors, together with a degree of pressure from racers, coaches and parents for re-runs, combined to generate a level of stress and an atmosphere that was ripe for the commission of errors.

RUN 3

8. On the third run there was confusion over a number of electronic times because one racer (No.1) knocked the wand and started the timing as he came into the start gate. It was noticed by Chf of Calcs that the clock was running but that no racer was on course. There was a communication problem between the starter and timing and before the problem could be sorted out the racer began his run and another start pulse was generated. The Chf of Calcs realised this and manually entered a finish pulse to annul the first start pulse before the racer actually finished. In the confusion the Chf of Calcs accidentally deleted a set of pulses from his screen and so the next racer (No. 11) received no time on the computer. The confusion with racer 1 knocking the wand also led the Chf of Calcs to believe there may have been a problem with the racer before No.1 (Racer 15). Because of these problems the Chf of Calcs elected to calculate back-up times for each of these racers.

9. On later reflection the Chf of Calcs believed he may have made a mistake in using a back-up time for racer 15. The Chf of Calc brought this to the TD's attention and she asked the secretary for the timing strips for closer inspection.

10. The printed out timing strips show all timing pulses.

11. Racer 15 has a start and finish pulse, which is interrupted by nothing and therefore the electronic time and not the back-up should be used.

12. There is then a start pulse of 16:04:29:823; this is the pulse when racer no.1 knocked the wand. There is then another start pulse of 16:04:44:438. This pulse is the pulse when racer 1 actually started his run.

13. Next there is a finish pulse, manually entered (16:04:55:199) by the Chf of Calcs before racer 1 finished.

14. 16:04:57:248 is the next pulse and is the actual finish pulse when racer 1 finished.

15. There are then a set of start and finish pulses showing Start 16:05:05:944 and finish 16:05:18:706. These are the pulses that Chf of Calcs accidentally deleted from his screen and are the timing pulses for racer 11.

16. Therefore instead of the three back-up times used:

Racer 15 - 12.57

Racer 1 - 12.61

Racer 11 - 12.53

The actual times that should be used are:

Racer 15 - 12.61

Racer 1 - 12.81

Racer 11 - 12.76

17. This alters the positions of 2nd - 6th as follows:

18.2. Endorses the revised results for seeding.


18.3. Arranges for the issue of medals to reflect the revised finish positions, both overall and within category.
