Piste conditions

As indicated in Update 1 the organisers will post the most up to date information on the event on the www.britski.org and www.barsc.net .

BARSC continues to do everything it can to ensure that the event takes place.

As at today, 26th December, BARSC and les Menuires regret that it will not be possible to run the championship with a full programme of races.

Please note that we anticipate running the FIS programme on 31st and 1st (team captains 30th) this advances the programme by 1 day. The FIS super G will be cancelled and the new programme will consist of 1 slalom and one GS. The current plan for the children's programme is for 1 one run slalom and 1 one run GS plus at least one mini race.

We anticipate that the races will take place in Val Thorens, VT is accessible by car, coach or uplift

There will be no further Updates unless conditions force a change of plan when the organisers arrive on 28th December. A full programme will be published as soon as possible on 28th/29th December.
