Piste conditions

As indicated previously the organisers will post the most up to date information on the event on the www.britski.org and www.barsc.net .

BARSC continues to do everything it can to ensure that the event takes place.

As at today, 28th December, BARSC and les Menuires regret that it will not be possible to run the championship with a full programme of races.

Anticipated timetable FIS

The FIS super G has been cancelled and we propose the new FIS programme of one slalom and one GS. Please note that we anticipate running the FIS programme in Val Thorens on 31st December (Slalom) and 1st January (GS) The First team captains' meeting will be on 30th December in les Menuires Club des Sports; this advances the programme by 1 day.

Anticipated timetable Children/minis

We propose a programme in Val Thorens and les Menuires. 2nd January, two run GS in Val Thorens. Course setter 11.30, Jury 12.00; Inspection 12.15 12.45 Start run 1 Minis will run first in run 1 or run 2 to be determined.

It is planned to hold two slaloms in Les Menuires. These will take place on either the stade or les Combes piste subject to conditions. The date will be 2 days chosen from 3rd, 4th, 5th - further information will be available in resort. The organisers are negotiating for a piste for a second mini race but this cannot be promised at the moment.

Uplift

Val Thorens has a separate lift company to les Menuires but it is possible to buy passes for the whole area in either resort.

Uplift lift passes for the stade in VT are on sale at Setam in the afternoon prior to each race. The organising committee are not able to provide lift passes.

Val Thorens is accessible by car, private coach or uplift for les Menuires. NB uplift not possible for an 8.00 pm start.
