RACE and EQUIPMENT RULES

These championships will be run under International Competition Rules (ICR); for Children/ Minis these are amended by British Rules (BCR). Competitors and coaches should make sure that they are aware of these. The ICR can be downloaded from www.britski.org. Amendments (precisions) for the Northern Hemisphere are normally published each year in November.

Equipment Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their equipment, including ski length and radius, conforms to discipline specifications.

NEW: All competitors and Forerunners must wear approved CRASH HELMETS for all disciplines.

Minis - are not permitted to wear cat suits while competing.

ENTRIES

Online Entry should be available from 1st November 2006

All competitors who have registered/re-registered (including BASS) with their Home Nation for 2007 will be able to enter the BARSC Championships online. Visit: <https://www.freestyleweb.co.uk/compentry/index.asp> and follow the instructions. At peak times, there may be a few days' delay after registration before online entry is available. If the delay is more than 3 working days, please contact your Home Nation office.

Postal Entries

Postal Entries must be made on the official race entry form – one per competitor – and be accompanied by the correct Race Entry Fee.

Race Entry Fee

Juniors/Children: £35.00 per competitor, per race for members of BARSC Clubs and £ 40.00 per competitor, per race for Non-BARSC Club members.

Minis: £20.00 per competitor, per race for BARSC Club members and £ 22.00 per competitor, per race for Non-BARSC Club members.

Entries should be sent to the Championship Secretary: Ros Humphrey, Berries, 8 Cambridge Way, Uckfield, East Sussex, TN22 2AD. **Closing date for UK entries - Friday, 01 December 2006.**

Late Entry will incur a penalty of £10.00 per race and competitor and be dependent on the race being undersubscribed.

Resort Entries should be handed into the Race Office between 15.00h and 16.00h on Saturday, 30 December 2006 (in Les Menuires) and will be considered by the Organising Committee. Competitors are warned that their presence in the resort will not necessarily gain them entry into the races.

International FIS Junior competition - All entries must arrive via the racer's National Ski Federation on the appropriate FIS entry forms within the time frame identified in ICR.

International Children and Minis competition - All entries must be made on the official race entry form and be accompanied by the Race Entry fee, signed Athlete Declaration and proof of valid racing insurance and arrive by 01 December 2006.

Refunds

Due to the enormous cost in organising these championships, there will be no refund of race entry fees once a race entry has been accepted even if one or more races are cancelled.

ACCEPTANCE

British competitors

Junior/Children must be registered with BASS for the 2006/2007 competition year.

Junior racers must also hold a valid full, limited or ghost FIS licence for the 2006/2007 season. To apply for a FIS licence, please contact Snowsport GB a minimum of 3 weeks prior to any event. The application form can be downloaded from <http://www.snowsportgb.com/Forms>. Acceptance into the Junior Championships is subject to FIS rules. Racers without a valid FIS Licence cannot be accepted into any FIS competition.

Minis – PLEASE NOTE: Competitors in the **Minis** category must either submit a signed Snowsport GB Athlete Declaration with the race entry or be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body. Unregistered Minis must also submit with their race entries proof of public liability insurance, which includes cover for racing.

International competitors

Junior FIS ICR apply.

Children/minis The organising committee may accept a limited number of international entries. These must be on the official form, include the race entry fee, signed Athlete Declaration & proof of valid insurance and arrive by 1/12/2006.

Priority

Junior championships will be subject to FIS regulations. The organising committee aim to accept all British entries, however they reserve the right to give priority to BARSC club members and/or racers with low seed points.

Children/Minis The organising committee aim to accept the maximum number of entries; however they reserve the right to give priority to members of BARSC clubs and (Children only) racers with low seed points.

All competitors MUST have appropriate insurance that covers them for ski racing.

By making an entry into these championships, competitors indicate that they are of a suitable ability; the organising committee reserve the right to exclude any competitor who is judged unsafe.

Seeding will be based on FIS points/BASS points current at the time of the race. Children's races will be subject to BCR.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

Clubs winning a Challenge Trophy will be allowed to retain the Trophy on condition that it is returned – clean and engraved – to BARSC in time for the 2008 Championships at the Club's expense.

Last year's winners should return the Trophies by either sending them by Recorded Delivery to the Championship Secretary or handing them into the Race Office on the day of the 1st Team Captains' Meeting (Sunday, 31 December 2006).

RESORT

LES MENUIRES is one of the three resorts in the Belleville Valley, which is itself one of the world famous Three Valleys. Les Menuires markets itself as 'The Smile of The Alps' because of the semi-circular arc of its main building complex and its good sunshine record. The main facilities are in La Croisette, the original centre, and Les Bruyeres. Les Menuires skiing radiates out in all directions from the resort and it's a tough choice to decide which way to head first thing in the morning. Other activities available include a skating rink, paragliding, fitness centre, snowmobiles, outdoor heated swimming pool and cross country trails.

DECLARATION

To be signed by the racer (or parent/guardian if the racer is under 18 years of age*)

1. I am eligible to enter these Championships.
2. I fully understand that a high standard of behaviour is expected of all competitors on and off the snow. I agree to accept the ruling of the Organising Committee on all disciplinary matters to the extent that racers may be excluded from races or have prizes withheld in cases of a breach of discipline or unacceptable behaviour, and that in the case of such an occurrence no monies will be refunded.
3. I am medically fit to race.
4. I undertake to be fully insured for racing (including accident, illness and third party cover), and will produce proof of such insurance to the Organising Committee when so required.
5. I will attend the prize-giving ceremonies and understand I will relinquish any claims to prizes, trophies or any other benefits should I fail to do so.
6. I agree that if I am awarded a perpetual trophy, I will have it engraved, safeguard it and return it before the next Championships as requested by BARSC.
7. I hereby free and relieve BARSC, their Officers and Voluntary Assistants of any liability for injury, loss or damage of any kind incurred by me/my child whether due to gross negligence or otherwise.
8. I have signed a copy of the FIS athlete's declaration (*Juniors only*), and lodged it with Snowsport GB / I have signed a copy of the athlete's declaration (*Children and Minis*), and lodged it with my Governing Body.*
9. I will wear a crash helmet at all times while racing and training.
10. I understand that the entry fee is not refundable, even if one or more of the races are cancelled as BARSC has incurred liabilities in setting up the Championships.
