These races will be run under FIS ICR and SSGB BCR rules, supplemented by the November 2007 precisions as appropriate.

FIS Licenses Ghost licences have been abolished by FIS; all junior racers must have a full or limited FIS Licence for the 2007/8 season - available from SSGB.

NB For all FIS Licence applications, racers must first renew their Home Nation registration for 2008. For UK residents, this guarantees public liability insurance for racing throughout the period of the FIS Licence. As in previous years, all applications/renewals received by SnowsportGB after 3rd August 2007 will be subject to a surcharge.

Children Super G All Children 2 will be required to race using Super G skis (minimum length 175cm, minimum radius 27m); Children 1 may race using GS skis (minimum radius 14m) - subject to ratification in November.

Additional races/training In addition to these Championships and the training camps arranged by BARSC affiliated clubs, BARSC hope to organise additional FIS Super G races in early March 2008. Watch the website for details.
