Equipment

Athletes, parents and coaches are reminded of the current FIS equipment rules especially Ch II super G and Junior 1 boys slalom skis. Children 2 Super-G skis (minimum length 175cm, minimum radius 27m); Children 1 may race using GS skis (minimum radius 14m) Junior 1 boys Slalom now minimum 165cm -10cm tolerance) Details on Ch II super G were included in both the invitation and acceptance bulletins. It is the athlete and coach's responsibility to ensure that they conform.
