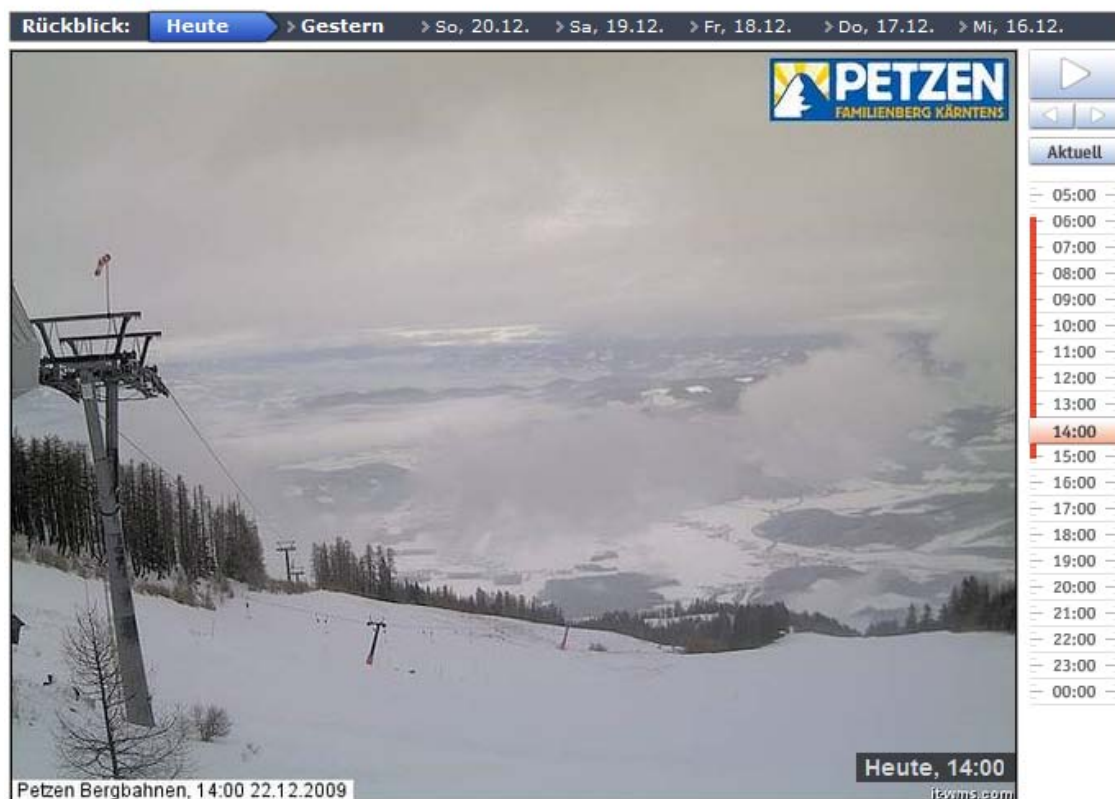


## Petzen Report 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec 2009

Petzen /1700 m



This was the snow and weather at 14.00 today.

After more than 10 days of freezing temperatures (-15/-20° Celsius) and permanent snow production the upper lift (Siebenhütten) opened on Saturday. There was more than 40 cm of man made snow.

The lower lift (Stollenlift) should have opened today, Tuesday, however there has been a storm, the Föhn, with winds of 80-100kph. This stopped the gondola working on both days so we do not have a firm report of today's conditions. The forecast for Wednesday is similar and then until Friday or Saturday it will be warmer with the possibility of snow, sleet or rain on the hill! The forecast for Saturday is -7 with snow at 1,900 metres; Sunday will be -3 and sunny.

At this stage we are not planning any change to the advertised programme but are working with the resort to ensure we cover all bases.
