

Scottish Indoor Ski Championships

BULLETIN 2

ENTRIES: Entry fee of £30 (plus an additional £4 if non-member Bairn) is payable by cheque (made payable to Snowsport Scotland), or by Visa, MasterCard or Maestro. Forms can be found at <http://www.snowsportsotland.org/competitions-calendar/ski-racing> and should be returned to Snowsport Scotland, Caledonia House, South Gyle, Edinburgh, EH12 9DQ no later than 5pm on the 4th November 2011.

RUNNING ORDER /SEED POINTS: Running order will be on the basis of BARTS List 2011.5. adjusted for snow with the top 15 seeded racer running first but after the Bairns. The last BARTS (2011.6) list of the season will be produced after this race.

RACE RULES: The Championships will be run under FIS rules as varied by SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) 2008. RACE FORMAT: The race will be run to the following format consisting of 2 runs down two different courses.

CHAMPIONSHIP TIMETABLE: Schedule and timings.

08:30 Race Bib Collection
08:45 – 09:15 Practice on tow slope
09:15 – 09:45 1st Run Course Inspection
10:00 Start of first run Slalom
12:00 – 12:30 2nd Run Course Inspection
12:45 Start of second run Slalom
15:00 Team Parallel Slalom

This timetable is provisional and Racers/Coaches/Parents should ensure that they check updates on the Official Notice Board throughout the Championships.

START LISTS: These will be available on www.britski.org prior to the event; however there will be start lists showing running order available on the morning of the event.

BIB COLLECTION: These will be available in the room next to the top of the stairs.

COURSE INSPECTION: The method of course inspection will be from the top down. Bibs must be worn with the numbers clearly displayed. Competitors must not ski down the prepared course or ski through the gates.

RACE OFFICE, JURY ROOM AND OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD: These will be outside the registration office.

PUBLICITY & PROMOTIONS: Photographers and videographers (official & non-official) may be present at Snowsport Scotland events. Images taken at these events may be used for the purpose of publicity and promotion of our sport. Snowsport Scotland can't practically police all potential images taken from open sporting events however if you wish to "opt out" from any or all official Snowsport Scotland imagery please contact; info@snowsportsotland.org

TEAM PARALLEL SLALOM: This is a fun event run on informal lines as a knockout. It is open to all racers competing in the Championships but they must register for the race at bib collection. Teams will be allocated by the organisers to give a balanced mix of abilities to make this a fun and fair event. Teams will be posted on the notice board in the bib collection room at 11am.

UPLIFT: The cost of uplift is included in the Championships entry fee. Competitors using the uplift facilities must clearly display their race numbers when doing so.

FIRST AID: First aid service will be provided by SNO!zone Scotland. The first aid room is situated on the ground floor of the main slope.

EQUIPMENT, HEALTH AND SAFETY: Racers' skis must be fitted with operational ski brakes.

HELMETS: All participants must wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet appropriate for skiing during training and competitions. (The European standard for ski helmets is BS EN1077:1996 specification for helmets for Alpine skiers).

UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOUR: Due to the increasing frequency of unsportsmanlike behaviour at dry slope races following gate faults, including carrying on to cross the Finish Line, swearing and pole abuse, all TD's and Race Organisers have been reminded that sanctions are to be applied if behaviour contravenes competition rules. Please be aware that this could ultimately lead to the sanction of 'Suspension from events' (ICR 223.3.2).

DISQUALIFICATIONS AND PROTESTS: Disqualifications will be posted on the official notice board following the Jury meeting after each run of the Slalom. Racers will have 15 minutes from the time of posting to protest against disqualification. Each protest (which should be made to the Referee) must be in writing and be accompanied by a deposit of £25 which will be forfeited in the event of such Protest not being upheld by the Jury.

TROPHIES AND MEDALS:

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd male and female competitors in each category.

All prize winners are expected to show courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

RACE DAY PRACTICE: The slope is available for racers to practice on prior to the race from 08:45. Please be aware that the slope will be open to the general public and ski school classes will be running during the day. Extreme care and attention must be taken at all times. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the race.

SKI SERVICING: Racers are reminded that hot waxing is **NOT** permitted within any of the buildings.

CATERING: Hot drinks and food will be available for purchase at the Bar & Cafe.

OFFICIALS: Please note that these events can only run successfully if we get sufficient volunteers to help with the various jobs. If you are able to assist, please contact the Chief of Race.
