## Update

Happy New Year to all BARSC registered clubs and racers

### Champoluc, December 2011

The conditions throughout Europe were unusual in November and early December 2011, races at all levels from World Cup to FIS NJR and national races were cancelled or rescheduled.

BARSC and Monterosa Ski did all that they could to keep entrants informed and to make decisions in line with the weather forecasts and past experience. Despite that it became necessary to cancel the FIS NJR races on 10<sup>th</sup> December and entrants were informed on 11<sup>th</sup> December.

This decision was made as soon as it became obvious that the races could not go ahead, that there would be insufficient natural snow to allow a piste to be prepared to FIS specifications and that the temperature would be too high to make sufficient artificial snow on the FIS homologated piste.

In line with standard practise and the race invitation no refund of race entry can be guaranteed or offered for races cancelled before or during the event but a letter has been prepared and posted on Britski.org and BARSC.net for those who can make a claim to their insurance company.

The BARSC board will consider the matter of entry refunds when the final accounts have been settled.

### Meribel 28<sup>th</sup> January 2012

Entries are currently being taken for the inaugural FIS BARSC/K sponsored Super combined race planned between the Welsh and Schoolboys/Girls in Meribel

This event will offer athletes the opportunity to gain both Super G and Super combined points prior to the English races in Bormio in February and the British Championships in Meribel in March as well as offering excellent experience

### Bormio 11<sup>th</sup> February 2012

The final BARSC FIS event will take place in Bormio on the Stelvio World Cup Piste. In order to make things simple and keep back office costs down we are working with our colleagues in SSE to run this event. All entries will be through the SSE online entry system and Andrea will act as Race Secretary. This event will give J/S Super G training, two FIS Super Gs as well as FIS NJR and FIS technical races.
