**RACE DATE:** Sat 4<sup>th</sup> and Sun 5<sup>th</sup> Feb 2012

**RACE TYPE :** Slalom both days

**AGE CATAGORIES:** Children 1, Children 2 , Junior 1 and Junior 2.

**ENTRY:** Race Entry Fee is **£40.00** for the weekend. Entries should be submitted to Snowsport Scotland at least 7 days before the event.

**RUNNING ORDER AND SEED POINTS:** For insurance purposes race competitors must be a member of a club affiliated to Snowsport Scotland if not registered as a competitor with a Home Nation. Also as this is a BASS seeded race competitors must also be registered as a competitor with Snowsport Scotland or other home nation.

**LAST YEARS WINNERS :** Last year's trophies should be returned as soon as possible to; Gill Barker, Chief of Championship, c/o Aberdeen Snowsports Centre, Garthdee Road, Aberdeen AB10 7BA. This must be done at least 7 days prior to race.

### CHAMPIONSHIP TIMETABLE:

**Jury Meeting** = TBC ... Aberdeen Snowsports Centre.

Bib collection times, course inspection, race times etc will be posted in follow-up bulletins.

**START LISTS:** These will be available on [www.britski.org](http://www.britski.org) and [www.snowsportscotland.org](http://www.snowsportscotland.org)

**COURSE INSPECTION:** The method of course inspection will be from the top down. Bibs must be worn with the numbers clearly displayed. Competitors must not ski down the prepared course or ski through the gates.

**UPLIFT:** The cost of uplift is not included in the race entry fee. Competitors using the uplift facilities must clearly display their race numbers when doing so.

**FIRST AID:** Provided by Glenshee Ski Patrol.

**EQUIPMENT, HEALTH AND SAFETY:** Racers' skis must be fitted with operational ski brakes

**HELMETS:** All participants must wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet appropriate for skiing during training and competitions. (The European standard for ski helmets is BS EN1077:1996 specification for helmets for Alpine skiers).

**UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOUR:** In the event of unsportsmanlike behaviour following gate faults, including carrying on to cross the Finish Line, swearing and pole abuse, all TD's and Race Organisers have been reminded that sanctions are to be applied if behaviour contravenes competition rules. Please be aware that this could ultimately lead to the sanction of 'Suspension from events' (ICR 223.3.2).

**DISQUALIFICATIONS AND PROTESTS:** Disqualifications will be posted on the official notice board following the Jury meeting after each run of the Slalom. Racers will have 15 minutes from the time of posting to protest against disqualification. Each protest (which should be made to the Referee) must be in writing and be accompanied by a deposit of £25 which will be forfeited in the event of such Protest not being upheld by the Jury.

**MEDALS:** Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd male and female competitors in each category. All prize-winners are expected to show courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

**CATERING:** Hot drinks and food will be available for purchase at the Cairnwell Cafe.

**OFFICIALS:** Please note that these events can only run successfully if we get sufficient volunteers to help with the various jobs. If you are able to assist, please contact the Chief of Race or Chief of Championship.
