Lecht Bairns 2012 – Bulletin 1

We are planning to run the Lecht Bairns Race on Saturday 21st January. At present there is enough snow to run the race, however conditions will be monitored over the next couple of weeks and a final inspection will take place on Friday 20 January.

Open to Bairns/Minis with a Year of Birth 2001 and later.

Organisers are prepared to accept late entries (i.e. received Thursday 19th by 17:00), but will not accept entries on the day without a very good reason. Cost of entry is £10 per child.

Insurance: racers must be a member of a club affiliated to Snowsport GB. If not a charge of £4 will be charged to cover the racers insurance for the event. **Racers must show proof of Insurance cover at Bib collection.**

Racers should report to the blue hut adjacent to south car park – the old Ski School – now the Gordon Skiers hut. Bib collection will commence from 08:30 – please note that GDN skiers will require access to the hut before 08:30 and for this reason we ask to remain outside until 08:30.

Dependant on the number of entries the race will comprise the best 2 times out of 3 runs on Giant Slalom course.

Bairns will be subdivided into 3 categories per gender type based on their YOB: 2001/2002, 2003/2004 & >2004

The course will be set up on either the Eagle 2 or the Raceway in between Eagles 1 & 2. This is most southerly of all pistes and can be accessed from the chairlift, or the poma to the left of the chairlift, and skiing left across the access path at the top of the hill. It can also be accessed on foot from the main car park.

Head protection is mandatory.

Presentation will take place shortly after the race in the Lodge, once the results have been finalised.

Acceptance lists will be posted on Britski and Snowsport Scotland websites.

The race will go ahead unless you hear otherwise. In the event that it is cancelled due to snow conditions etc you will be emailed (those who provided an email address) and I will attempt to post a very late bulletin via Britski.org and Snowsport Scotland websites.

Catsuits will not be permitted for Bairns races.
