Snowsport England BASS Indoor Races.

Saturday 25th to Monday 27th May 2013

at SnowWorld, Landgraaf, Netherlands

These will be the first BASS races of the 2013/14 season and will be an ideal opportunity to gain early BASS points. In the case of Junior, Senior and Masters competitors points gained may be taken into account when applying for full and limited FIS licences for 2013/14.

The races will be run in accordance with British Competition Rules (BCR – FIS as amended by BSS).

All competitors must wear a helmet in accordance with FIS rules.

Snowsport England is grateful to SnowWorld for hosting these races and to the clubs and individuals who have already offered to help with the organisation of the event.

The slalom races for the U10 and U12 age groups will use stubbie gates.

ENTRY CRITERIA

To participate in the event British and Irish competitors must be registered with their Home Nation.

All competitors must have a current insurance policy that permits them to ski race. The Race organizers will require proof of insurance such as a valid governing body race licence or an independent certificate of insurance.

Entries are welcomed from the following age groups:

U10 Year of birth 2004 and 2005
U12 Year of birth 2002 and 2003

U14	Year of birth 2000 and 2001
U16	Year of birth 1998 and 1999
U18	Year of birth 1996 and 1997
U21	Year of birth 1993, 1994 and 1995
Senior	Year of birth 1984 to 1992
Masters	Year of birth 1983 and earlier

The entry fee for the complete programme of events is £50. There is a reduced fee of £40 for entries received up to end of day on Monday 6th May.

Competitors may also enter on the official entry form, one per competitor and entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the correct competition entry fee.

Competitors who don't wish to enter the complete programme may enter individual events. The fee for each Slalom race will be £20, the Giant Slalom fee is £10. Please contact the Race Secretary.

Cheques for postal entries must be made payable to: Snowsport England and the entry form and payment sent to the Race Secretary, Sylvia Flahive, 12 Holborn Close, St Albans, Herts AL4 9YG.

Entries are on a first come basis. An initial entry list will be published on Tuesday 7th May.

The closing date for entries is Friday 17th May 2013.

Entries received after the closing date will be subject to an additional late entry fee of £10.

Competitors NOT staying at SnowWorld will need to pay a slope fee of €27.50 per race day. This payment should be paid on arrival at SnowWorld and must be paid before bib issue on the race day.

AWARDS (BASS SLALOM RACES)

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place both Female and Male races:

Overall U16 and younger

Overall U18 and older

U10, U12, U14, U16, U18, U21, Senior and Masters age groups

TEAM EVENT (for the TEAM EVOLUTION trophy)

There will also be an award for the leading club over the 2 days of Slalom racing based on the aggregate of points gained from 1st (3 points), 2nd (2 points) and 3rd (1 point) places in each age group.

TRAINING (SATURDAY 25th MAY)

The race slope will be available for training throughout the day on Saturday 25th May.

Each training lane has a comfortable capacity of 15 trainees.

The cost for training on Saturday is €27.50 per person.

For competitors who are staying in the SnowWorld hotel this training fee will be included in the daily package for Saturday.
