English Alpine Ski Championships return to Bormio 2017 marks 10th anniversary in the Italian resort

Snowsport England have confirmed that the English Alpine Ski Championships will return to Bormio, Italy in 2017, marking the event's 10th year in the authentic Italian ski and spa town.

After a hugely successful event in 2016, which saw over 400 competitors aged from Under 10 upwards battle it out for supremacy on the slopes, 2017 will see Bormio play host to the $21^{\rm st}$ English Alpine Ski Championships running from Saturday $11^{\rm th}$ – Friday $17^{\rm th}$ February.

The 2016 English Alpine Championships were again blessed with good weather and not only hundreds of competitors, but also hundreds of coaches, supporters, parents and volunteers, making for a unique and buzzing atmosphere.
